

Documents Stored at Meadville Lombard Theological School in Chicago

- Three file folders with materials dated 1938-1983, with the bulk from the 1950s
- Types of items:
 - Correspondence and memoranda
 - Religious education programs
 - Annual reports to the Universalist Church of America, and later the annual questionnaires to the Unitarian Universalist Association
 - Annual reports of the congregation (a few, mostly 1950s; one from 1980)
 - Universalist Church of America field reports
 - A few administrative documents re: church property (20th century)
 - Treasurer's reports and some financial records
 - Photographs – black and white, undated but looks like the 1950s
 - Pamphlets and brochures
 - Some newspaper clippings
- Items of interest
 - Transcript of 125th Anniversary Address, 1945 by Pearce M. Gabell
 - A copy of the congregational history from 1975
